

Troy Lebane (he/him) is a Toronto-based vocalist, songwriter, and educator. As a graduate of the ESA Music Theatre program and the McGill Concurrent B.Mus/B.Ed program, Troy is a multi-instrumentalist who has performed on many stages across North-America, including in Toronto, Montreal, Ottawa, Niagara Falls, NYC, Boston, and Chicago.

Troy is also an avid and versatile composer and arranger, whose compositions have won the ORMTA and CFMTA composer competitions. His work has been performed in both provincial and national festivals by the Etobicoke School of the Arts Chamber Choir, as well as professionally by the Mississauga Festival Choir. In 2021, Troy's original musical *The Elephant* premiered at TNC in Montreal and his musical contributions to the McGill Classics play *MetAMORphoses* appeared the following year.

Since 2022, Troy has been the grade 3-6 music teacher at Royal St. George's College (RSGC), where he co-directs the annual junior school musical and acts as a technical director for the theatre space. He spearheaded the creation of the middle school songwriting and production program at RSGC where students can use state-of-the-art techniques and technology to hone their creative skills. Outside of RSGC, he freelances as a private vocal coach, guest artist, presenter, and panellist.
